

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- 1. The Tournament will be conducted under the present rules and regulations of Tennis Victoria.
- 2. Entries must be made on the Official Entry Form or a facsimile thereof, and all entries must be paid at time of entry. No player shall be allowed to play in any event unless the entrance fee has been paid.
- 3. The Committee shall have the entire control and management of the Tournament.
- 4. The Committee may refuse entry and shall not be required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 5. Competitors may enter only one event on each day.
- 6. NOTE: Round Robin D Grade entries MUST BOTH BE D GRADE STANDARD.
- 7. Play-offs will be held if there is more than one section in a Grade for Round Robin events.
- 8. No competitor may transfer his/her entry in any event to another player, except with the consent of the Committee.
- 9. If a competitor withdraws from a Round Robin competition all their match results will be annulled.
- 10. Play will commence punctually as notified each day. Any competitor not reporting for his/her match when called will be disqualified. This rule will be strictly enforced.
- 11. Players must report to the Tournament Desk immediately on arrival at the courts and are strictly forbidden to leave the courts without approval from the Committee.
- 12. The Referee shall be the sole judge as to whether the courts and/or conditions are fit for play and he/she shall decide whether or not a match will be postponed or discontinued.
- 13. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event if the entry be deemed unsatisfactory.
